United Arab Emirates-listed carrier Air Arabia and Sudanese conglomerate DAL Group have partnered to launch a new airline based in Sudan's Khartoum International Airport.

Air Arabia Sudan will be a joint venture between the two companies. No details were provided regarding the ownership structure.

The Khartoum-based start-up will operate a fleet of new Airbus A320 aircraft and will adopt the low-cost business model operated by Air Arabia on its existing network.

Air Arabia's legal team was led by group head of legal, **Osama Romeih** (pictured) while DAL Group legal team was led by **Mahasin Bandi**, senior legal advisor.
