The 27th Conference of the Parties ("COP27"), currently being held in Egypt, witnessed the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") between Majid Al Futtaim Holding Company, the UAE Ministry of Climate Change and Environment and Environment Agency – Abu Dhabi ("EAD").
